The Inn is within walking distance of restaurants, gift and antique shops as well as area attractions including battlefield tours and the National Cemetery. Visit a nearby state park for a picnic, take a driving tour of scenic Adams County or slow down indoors browsing the area's shops filled with Civil War collectibles. - \$89-\$169, Double Occupancy; \$25 for additional person in rooms that will accommodate them. Rates subject to 9% taxes. Payment by cash, check, Visa, MasterCard, or Discover accepted.
